- 3. PUBLIC REPRESENTATION** - members of the public are invited to raise any matters of concern for a maximum of 15 minutes.
- 4. TO CONFIRM MINUTES OF MEETING HELD ON 13<sup>th</sup> October 2011** (previously circulated).
- 5. CHRISTMAS LIGHTS** – to agree supply of Christmas lighting at cost of **£1117 + VAT** for purchase of lights (Festival Lights £480), installation (Charlestown £487 + VAT) and supply and power (Street Lighting £150); and to consider monies needed for refreshments for event (wine and mince pies).
- 6. FLOWER BEDS** – to discuss the replanting of flower beds outside the Post Office, with a view to clarifying the agreement with BMDC concerning this issue.
- 7. HARDEN PRIMARY SCHOOL PLANTING PROPOSAL** – to consider the possibility of helping to fund Harden Primary School's hanging basket scheme (total cost £500: Community Chest agreed to provide £250 plus match any amount agreed by Harden Parish Council).
- 8. MEMORIAL HALL FEASIBILITY STUDY** – to discuss meeting with Denholme Town Council representatives with a view to undertake a proposed feasibility study covering Denholme Mechanics Hall and Harden Memorial Hall, funded by BMDC.
- 9. BOUNDARY CHANGES** – to discuss the Boundary Commission's proposal to abolish the Shipley Constituency and include Harden (Bingley Rural) within the Bradford West constituency.
- 10. ELECTION COSTS** – to consider the election costs estimate for Harden Parish Council received from BMDC.
- 11. YOUTH CLUB** – to receive an update on Youth Club numbers and activity.
