Resolved. The minutes, of the meeting held on 14th August 2011, are a true and accurate record. Cllr Andrews signed a copy of them.

05/0811 Youth Club – a) The Friday sessions have been quiet so far and will be reviewed with the Head of Youth Services if attendance doesn't pick up. Cllr Cummins will speak to the members of the Tuesday night session and emphasise the need to support the new session. The clerk will look at ways to publicise t he session in the local press. The Parish Council will consider suspending the sessions until the winter months if there is not sufficient need at the moment.

Arising from the discussion on the Youth Club the Parish council raised the issue of the state of the Memorial Hall and it was resolved to write a letter to BDMC regarding the matter.

b) The Parish Council have received another letter from Mr King regarding young people attending the Youth Club and congregating outside the Chemists. The Clerk will reply to Mr King highlighting the need for facilities for young people in the village and the Parish Council's commitment to honour the questionnaire requests to tackle the lack of activities and a place to meet. The Parish Council can in no way condone any bad behaviour in the centre of Harden but is satisfied the Youth Club is well monitored by the Youth Service and its own representative.

06/0811 Christmas Lights

A meeting was held with David Howes of Festival Lights to discuss further enhancing the village lights for Christmas this year. He has been asked to prepare a quote. The budget this year for lights is £1000, to include the switching on event. Initially the Butcher/ Post Office building was considered but this proved unsuitable. Another tree has therefore been identified as a possible for lights, adjacent to a lamppost, almost opposite the trees with lights and the Christmas tree area. The Chairman will contact Mr Crowther who owns the land and tree. Street Lighting have been asked to make a site visit to ascertain whether the tree is suitable and if the electricity supply can be taken safely from the lamppost. Wilsden band have been contacted to see how much it would cost to hire them for the Lighting up event.

OBJECT

In August 2010, the PC commented on the earlier application

'The Parish Council support in principle the filling in of the quarry but identify four areas of concern – water supplies for Rycroft, access routes for HGVs, types of waste accepted and the restoration of the site'.

The Parish Council re-iterates these comments and adds that it 'notes the Hydrogeological Appraisal and supports the suggestion in para 6.3 that to 'better understand the detailed hydrogeology of the sitespecific

investigation boreholes are required'. Further, the Parish Council supports the investigations proposed in para 7 to 'establish the potential for a connection or pathway between the quarry and the Rycroft water supplies'.

The Parish Council has serious concerns about the HGVs regarding the following; the number of HGVs during operating each day, the working hours over each day and the number of days of the week that the HGVs operate.

The Parish Council also wishes to state that modification should be made to the entrance of the site to prevent entry and egress from the site via Ryecroft Village.

The Parish Council feels that due to the nature of the application it should be determined by the Area Panel and not solely by the Planning Officers.

g) 11/03483/FUL Playground South Of Sport Turf Research Institute St Ives Estate Keighley Road

Use of land for 12.2 x 8.4 metre steel container for storage of equipment for Aire Valley Archers
